An early childhood educator, she received her doctorate in Education from the University of the Philippines in 1982; founded the Early Learning Center (1974-2005) and co-founded the Museo Pambata in 1993.

She is currently the President of All Together in Dignity (ATD) Fourth World Movement, an international non-government organization in 30 countries working together to overcome poverty.

She has authored 4 books, a workbook and has written articles on children's learning and development.
